50 YEARS. 50 CANDLES, 50 YEARS OLD. IN 2023, THE COUPE ICARE CELEBRATES ITS 50THANNIVERSARY.

If someone had told them, those handful of daredevils, pioneers, who in 1973 had the idea to gatherat the foot of the Chartreuse massif the handful of pilots who were then trying out hang gliding, avery fledgling discipline... If someone had told them that 50 years later, their event would still behere, attracting around **100,000 spectators from around the world every year**. If someone had toldthem that 50 years later, **their hang gliders would still be there, incredibly more efficient, and nowjoined by paragliding, but also base jumping, wingsuit flying, skydiving, gliding, hot air balloons,microlights, kite flying, boomerangs...** and so much more. If someone had told them that their smallgathering of insiders would become, 50 years later, **the world's largest popular festival dedicated tofree flight and aerial sports.** If someone had told them... Would they have believed it?

Yes, certainly. Because these pioneers, as crazy as they were perceived to be, were above allvisionaries. They understood early on that mankind's **oldest dream**, the dream of lcarus, to breakfree from gravity, was entering a new phase: that of democratization. The nascent free flight, light, without an engine, silent, inexpensive, and relatively safe, was beginning to benefit from technological innovations that allowed everyone to give it a try. They understood, already, that the sky, previously reserved for the military, transport companies, and a few wealthy eccentrics, was going to become a playground accessible to the masses. They understood that an event was needed to match the public's enthusiasm for these new ways of practicing outdoor activities and enjoying nature. So yes, it's certain: if someone had told them, they would have shrugged and replied, «Of course, the Coupe Icare will celebrate its 50th anniversary, and much more.»

A fiftieth anniversary. A beautiful and symbolic milestone for this young event. Yes, young. Young because it's constantly renewing itself. Young because the Coupe Icare reinvents itself every year: the event remains open to emerging practices and continually welcomes new disciplines of flight. New ways of soaring through the sky appear each year, new aerobatic figures take shape, innovations in equipment repeatedly push the boundaries of what is possible...

Territories are thus explored by new generations of young pilots, builders, athletes, and aerial artists. These new generations all gather at the Coupe Icare. And young, above all, because unanimously,when you take to the air, you remain young. Regardless of age.

50 years of Coupe Icare, but also 40 years of Icarnaval, the famous costume contest, and 30 years of Icare Ballons, the magnificent procession of hot air balloons. So many anniversaries to celebrate this year! More than ever, this 50th edition will be an opportunity to celebrate and party.

The Coupe Icare has experienced some difficulties over the past 50 years. For example, it was canceled in 1977 due to strong north winds. In 2020, the event was canceled again, this time due to an international crisis caused by a nasty virus that prevented outdoor enthusiasts from venturing outside. In 2021, the Coupe Icare had to comply with health measures to offer a successful and appreciated event, albeit with a reduced program. However, the Coupe Icare has always managed to bounce back and reinvent itself by incorporating new sports or artistic disciplines, launching new initiatives, and ensuring that each edition is more beautiful than the previous one.

For the past 50 years, the Coupe Icare and its numerous events have been a highlight on the agenda of the entire community of free flight and light aviation. Pilots, federations, manufacturers, importers, equipment suppliers-none of the actors in the different represented disciplines would miss the world's largest free flight event. The Coupe Icare is above all a great popular festival focused on the sky, with the aim of welcoming an increasingly larger audience each year to celebrate and share the culture of flight. It is also a professional trade show, a meeting place for the entire global economic and industrial sector.

Nearly 100,000 visitors will come with their families and friends to witness the aerial ballet of the greatest pilots, be moved by the incredible performances of artists from various backgrounds, soak up the festive atmosphere during the famous Icarnaval with its disguised pilots, or watch the beauty of the world from the sky on the big screen. The entire organizing team of the Coupe Icare, along with its 1,300 volunteers, is excited to welcome the free flight community once again. The Coupe Icare offers a range of festive, sporting, artistic, and cultural events for all audiences. Experienced and novice pilots, the general public, young and old, come together each year for a great moment of celebration and to marvel at the feats of the greatest pilots, applaud numerous artistic creations and events, and discover the latest innovations in a constantly evolving field. Over 6 days, paragliders, hang gliders, paramotors, balloons, aerobatic planes, and many other forms of light aviation sports take to the skies.

People from all over the world come to the heart of the lsère Alps to participate in this grand celebration. Created in 1974 by a group of passionate friends, the Coupe Icare now attracts nearly 100,000 spectators every September.. The Coupe Icare takes place just a stone's throw **away from Grenoble**, between the **Grésivaudan** Valley and **the Chartreuse Massif**, on the paragliding take-off areas of the Plateau des Petites Roches (Saint-Hilaire) clinging to the cliffs, and its vast landing area in Lumbin, 700 meters below.

1st Coupe Icare. 50 hang glider pilots, in this new discipline, gather in Saint-Hilaire for the first French precision landing competition. The people of Grenoble and the region witness for the first time the spectacle of «bird-men»; and the Grenoble-Chambéry road axis becomes paralyzed.

1983

1st International Aerial Film Festival. The first jury of the festival is chaired by Pierre-François Degeorges, host of the famous TV show «Les carnets de l'aventure»; on Antenne 2. A loyal friend of Saint-Hilaire, who never missed an edition of the festival until his death in 2003.

1983

the first spontaneous fancy dress flights that foreshadow what will make the reputation of the Coupe Icare, the spectacular Icarnaval.

1984

the used equipment market is born and the first professional exhibitors set up in the fields of Saint-Hilaire.

1993

the first aerobatic demonstrations in hang gliding and paragliding. It is also the year of the first hot air balloon events. **2004** the first motorized and kite demonstrations



COUPE ICARE 2023 : CLAUDIE HAIGNERÉ, A HIGH-FLYING GODMOTHER

NDRE-DESH

CLAUDIE HAIGNERÉ, THE FIRST FRENCH ASTRONAUT TO GO INTO SPACE, HAS ACCEPTED THE ROLE OF GODMOTHER FOR THE 50TH EDITION OF COUPE ICARE!

Deltaplanes, the flying objects at the heart of Coupe Icare's inception in the 1970s, have their origins in space exploration. In the late 1950s, NASA engineers were developing a new wing design for spacecraft reentry into the atmosphere. This wing needed to be foldable, lightweight, and easy to deploy.

The result was a flexible, triangular-shaped wing made of fabric. While the nascent space industry didn't pursue the project, pioneers of free flight embraced the concept and developed it into the deltaplane.

There is indeed a connection between space travel and Coupe Icare. Far-fetched? Perhaps, until this year. In 2023, Coupe Icare reaches for the moon with Claudie Haigneré, reinforcing the link between free flight and space exploration !

On August 17, 1996, Claudie Haigneré became the first Frenchwoman to go into space during a 16-day mission aboard the Russian space station Mir. In January 2001, she embarked on a space shuttle mission and became the first European woman to stay aboard the International Space Station (ISS).

Claudie Haigneré also served as the Minister Delegate for Research and New Technologies in 2002 and later became the Minister Delegate for European Affairs in March 2004.

For this 50th edition, the artists will be more numerous than ever, concerts will beeverywhere, and the brass bands will spread out in every corner ! To inspire, to move or astonish, toentertain and make this Coupe Icare a great moment of pleasure and celebration !

ICARE MÔMES (« ICARE KIDS »), TO DISCOVER AND MARVEL.

A dedicated space for young audiences to awaken their curiosity about things related to the Air and perhaps inspire some vocations ? The little ones can participate in activities related to aviation and aerology. Workshops to understand and experiment: weather and weather vane construction, origami and paper airplanes, water rockets, scientific exploration of air, kite making, gliders and wind turbines, creating costumes and windsocks using recycled paragliders, making paper balloons, constructing and learning to throw boomerangs, sky discovery, falconry demonstrations, bird listening and observation in nature, slackline demonstrations and initiation...



ICARE DU CINÉMA THE UNMISSABLE INTERNATIONAI AERIAL FILM FESTIVAL.

It has been one of the highlights of the Coupe Icare since 1983, with an average of 20,000 spectators in recent editions. A reference festival for image professionals and practitioners of free flight.

The Festival showcases cinematographic productions (short, medium, and feature films) around the theme of air, wind, flight, and all air sports such as paragliding, hang gliding, skydiving, hot air ballooning, powered paragliding, gliding, base jumping, kite flying, boomerang... Motorized air sports are limited to paramotoring, ultralights, aeromodelling, aerobatics, and aerial stunts. Films about bird flight are also accepted.

The Festival receives around a hundred films every year from around the world. After pre-selection, the best films will be submitted to the official Jury of the Festival : a jury composed of sports and image professionals (TV producers, directors...), as well as the Press Jury and a Children's Jury, consisting of CM2 students from schools in St Hilaire, Lumbin, and St Pancrasse.

The screenings of the official selection 2023 will start on Tuesday, September 19. The winners will be announced on Friday, September 22.

The landing area in Lumbin provides a fantastic space that hosts numerous activities, starting with the landings themselves. Because pilots know well that whatever takes off will eventually

have to land ! The goal is to execute this final phase of the flight with as much grace as possible. It's a spectacle in itself ! It's also the ideal area to observe all the aerial shows.

On this zone, there are also activities related to kite flying, ultralights, aeromodelling, kiting, and more.

The department of Isère offers a village organized around sports and recreational activities in thisarea: climbing walls, slackline, biathlon, virtual reality experiences, skateboarding, pump track for mountain biking and BMX, bicycle maintenance and repair workshops, as well as awareness campaigns for bird protection.

The lcare Landing zone is at the center of attention, but most importantly, at the heart of the valley. Access is free and easy : secure parking for electric bicycles, dedicated and secure cycling paths, shuttles from car parks.

40 years ago, a few pilots spontaneously decided to put on a show by dressing up, simply to make their friends laugh. They inspired others, and soon more and more pilots started preparing increasingly crazy costumes ! What began as a playful joke became the famous lcarnaval.

Today, it's a true highlight of the event, a competition of costumes that are more incredible and fantastic than the next! It's an aerial carnival full of surprises: the pilots amaze us with ever-increasing creativity, beauty, and skill in their disguises. It's a unique aerial parade in the world, taking the audience into an extravagant imaginary realm ! These spectacular costumed takeoffs make headlines in media outlets worldwide every year.

You can experience it live at the North takeoff area (La Moquette) as well as at the landing zone.

ICAROBATIX THE EXHILARATING SLALOM OF PARAMOTORS

Like its cousin paragliding, paramotoring is in a constant state of innovation and has an increasingnumber of practitioners. The «skyracers»; of Icarobatix will once again be present for this high-speed chase just above the ground, during which the world's best pilots compete against each other.

ICARE BALLONS, THE RENDEZVOUS OF HOT AIR BALLOONS.

Like a ritual celebrating sunrise and sunset, numerous hot air balloons rise slowly into the sky, gigantic and majestic ! Collective takeoffs of these hot air balloons, with varied shapes and colors, meandering through theair for our greatest delight! It's an opportunity for everyone federations, manufacturers, importers, retailers, schools, clubs,pilots, and the general public - to meet and exchange ideas about the latest innovations andeverything that makes up the various disciplines: flying equipment, technical clothing, accessories,instrumentation, technological innovations, and more.

A second-hand market is organized to allow practitioners to find good deals.

Among the participants, some organizations offer pilots the chance to recycle their used wings into everyday objects or generously donate their equipment in good condition to pilot schools in remote parts of the world, in emerging countries, to introduce everyone to the joys of flight.

Outdoor Sports & Recreation in Lumbin

Numerous manufacturers and retailers of outdoor sports equipment present their latest innovations for the whole family.

SAINT-HILAIRE

A medium-altitude mountain village with 1500 inhabitants, located on a natural promontory of the Chartreuse massif overlooking the Grésivaudan Valley. From its 2062m peak, the local summit of Dent de Crolles watches over this small village that cherishes the art of living throughout the seasons. Thanks to the Coupe Icare, it has become one of the most famous paragliding and hang gliding sites in the world. Highly popular among pilots for its flight potential, it is also an ideal holiday destination for families due to the diversity of activities and outdoor sports available, as well as its proximity to major cities and Alpine resorts.

• 2 ski resorts (Saint-Hilaire and Col de Marcieu) and 1 summer outdoor resort (Col de Marcieu)

- 4 paragliding and hang gliding take-off areas in the village
- 25 km from Grenoble and Chambéry (30-minute drive)
- Located within the Chartreuse Regional Natural Park

Saint-Hilaire is the site for hang gliding and paragliding takeoffs, located on the Plateau des Petites Roches, the eastern balcony of the Chartreuse massif, perched at 1000 meters above sea level. Lumbin, a small expanding village, hosts the landing fields in the heart of the Grésivaudan Valley.

LUMBIN

A village of approximately 2000 inhabitants located in the heart of the Grésivaudan Valley and Dauphiné region, the municipality of Lumbin hosts the paragliding and hang gliding landing areas throughout the year. On either side, the valley extends from Grenoble to the borders of Savoie, an economically dynamic territory with numerous businesses from various sectors. The Grésivaudan region is home to many international company headquarters. Over the years, the landing area hasdeveloped an artisanal zone that accommodates businesses related to outdoor sports.

AN ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK FOR THE WEEKEND

In partnership with local authorities (Grésivaudan community of municipalities, Isère department, and Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes region), an entire network of alternative transportation is offered to the public on Saturdays and Sundays to access the sites without a car. The operation works so well that the car parks in Saint-Hilaire are rarely full.

- Reduced-rate regional train
- Encouragement for carpooling





WASTE: LIMITING AND SOR-TING

We limit... by using reusable cups (1 euro deposit) in the colors of the Coupe Icare. This initiative is supported on-site by the local association Le Grand Tetras, responsible for informing and explaining the purpose of this approach. In terms of festival catering, cutlery and plates are compostable and recyclable, while dry toilets have replaced traditional chemical toilets.

And we sort... thanks to selective waste bins set up throughout the event by the association Aremacs (Association for recycling at cultural and sports events) in partnership with the Auvergne-Rhône- Alpes region..

ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY A COMMITMENT TO CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Flight slots for paramotors and other ultralight aircraft have been arranged to minimize noise pollution.

The organizing committee has also decided to no longer showcase vintage airplanes in aerial demonstrations and to eliminate helicopter rides from Lumbin.

The event hosts environmental awareness campaigns every year in collaboration with the Isère department, the League for the Protection of Birds, and the Chartreuse Regional Park.

Furthermore, the Coupe Icare is a must-attend event for aviation stakeholders who implement environmentally friendly initiatives. Free-flight practitioners, by definition, have close contact with natural environments and are particularly sensitive to environmental issues. For example, some participants will showcase new recycling techniques for the fabrics used in the construction of paragliders and hang gliders, giving a new life to aircraft that have contributed to this environmental awareness. It is from above that the planet appears most fragile...
